Please can you make sure you arrive at the correct time to prevent your child being marked late.

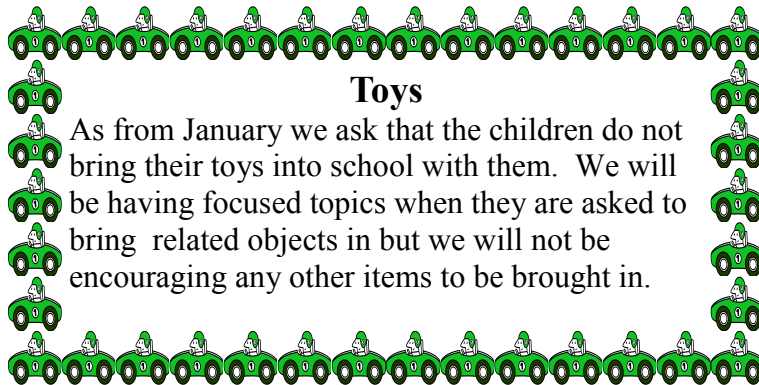
Caterpillars—8.45am

The gate in the afternoon will close at 12.40pm.

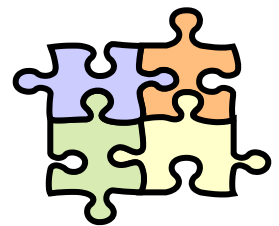


This term the children have enjoyed participating in a range of festive activities. The children worked hard on practising the Christmas performance we hope you enjoyed watching it.

We have been making Christmas cards.

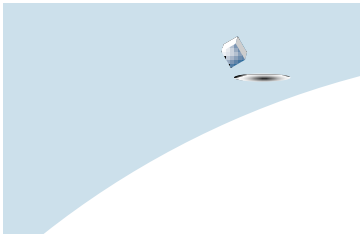
